REMINDER...

To All Certified Staff:

If you will be obtaining additional credit hours (semester hours) toward salary advancement this summer, please:

1. have the institution send the official transcript to my attention electronically, or
2. as an *unopened*, original, official transcript to the address at the bottom of this email.
3. If the original transcript is mailed directly to you, just forward to me, unopened. I'm happy to make a copy for your records, once it is opened. I always confirm via email, upon receiving any transcripts. Please call me if you *don't* hear from me.

There are *two important deadlines* for receipt of transcripts which could affect pay increases:

September 15 of any year

To receive proper placement on the salary schedule for a full year, your official transcript must be received in this office on or before September 15. If warranted, the increase will be retroactive, after board approval.

January 30 of any year

If requirements are met for an additional degree after September 15 and before January 30 of any year, the increase shall be prorated for a half year and paid over the remaining time of the contract, after board approval, as long as the transcript is received in this office by the January 30.

Grade reports, letters from your Dean stating grade/course number description on college letterhead, or a copy of your Master's diploma can be used to meet this deadline, but nothing will be recorded or increased until I have the official transcript.

Call or email me if you have any questions regarding the above.

I would suggest always sending in your transcripts *as you earn your additional certification*. We track for you, and always keep a running total for you.
